

Remote Access to the Virtual Lab

We are pleased to announce that students can remotely access a campus lab to assist you with your projects. The Virtual Shrine of Silver Monkey Lab computers have Maya, ZBrush, Substance Painter, and other software installed.

The Virtual Lab should be used the same way as the Silver Monkey Lab on campus – to work on your assignments and projects. This is not a place where scheduled classes take place – please continue to use Canvas for all your classes.

To connect and remotely access this virtual lab follow the steps below.

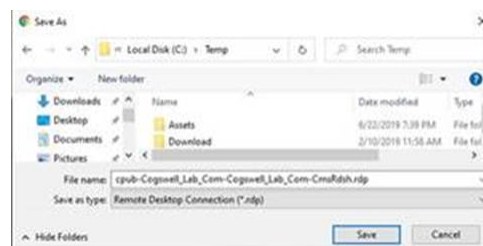
1. In your browser go to <https://remote.cogswell.edu/rdweb>
2. On the login prompt enter your Cogswell login credentials. You need to enter “cpc\” in front of your user name.



3. When Remote Desktop window opens, click on the “Cogswell Lab Computers” icon.



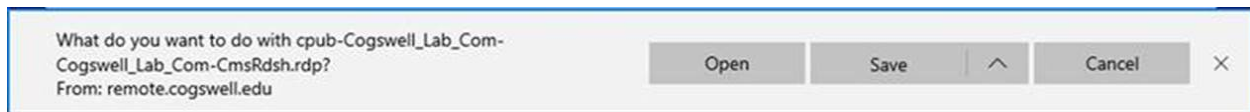
4. If you are using Chrome, a “Save As” window will open; click on the “Save” button



The configuration file will be downloaded from the server. Click on this file on the bottom of the Chrome window.



If you are using Microsoft Edge, the “What do you want to do...” prompt will appear; click on the “Open” button.



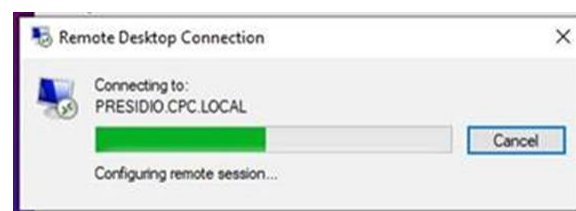
5. When a trust window opens, check “Don’t ask me again...” box and click the “Connect” button



6. You will be prompted to enter your password one more time.



7. A progress status window will appear and after a few seconds you will be connected to a remote computer.





8. While working on virtual computers please make sure to save all your files in your home directory on the server (Drive "Z:"). Once you finish your remote session, any files you put on disk "C:" will be inaccessible. Only files on "Z:" drive will be available next time you login to the Virtual Lab.
